# HIGHLIGHTS

## THINK TANK

### **Expanding Student Impact and Access**

THINK TANK served over 10,000 unique students through 72,466 total visits.

Utilization of Supplemental Instruction (SI) rose 16% year over year, reaching 34,317 visits, continuing a trajectory of growth and demonstrating sustained student interest.

Fee-based academic coaching transitioned to a free service in Spring 2025, expanding equitable access for all main campus students.

The New Start summer program partnership with the Thrive Center continued to grow, and saw an increase of ~250% in student tutoring visits from the previous year.

Academic Coaches provided support to 2,126 students enrolled in SAS100AX, as a complementary course for students in MATH 100.

The Writing Center facilitated 78 workshops for classes and student organizations.

Writing Center events engaged 224 students, including the inaugural Write Your Heart Drop-In Tutoring & Valentine Crafting, as well as the Finals Countdown WriteNite and a Global WriteNite event that featured a tutoring support in seven different languages.

### **Program Innovation and Strategic Development**

Academic Coaches and the Math Department co-developed and taught Math 196B, a placement-preparation course for students with no prior placement info.

A newly developed course, UNIV 100, will launch in Fall 2025, combining academic coaching and embedded tutoring to support a targeted subset of MATH 100 students.

THINK TANK co-led with Thrive Center the design and implementation of New Start+, a pilot summer support program that is a collaboration between THINK TANK's academic coaches and tutoring team, the Math Department, New Start, and Enrollment Management.

The Math & Science team worked to develop flexible, high-impact support outside of standard offerings; this includes several events piloted this year including Virtual Reality SI sessions using Meta Quest 3 headsets, and SGPP interdisciplinary Writing + Tutoring events

Tutoring began a new partnership with Korean Language Program to host instructor-led tutoring, expanding the support for students in language courses.

### **Recognition, Partnership, and Professional Leadership**

The tutoring team was recognized by Eller College of management as "Outstanding Campus Partner." This honor was awarded for meaningful engagement and contributions to student success in partnership with the college.

Two SI Leaders presented at the inaugural SI Leader Global Summit Conference — a program first.

Three tutors presented at the Rocky Mountain Writing Center Association TutorCon 2025. annual CRLA conference in Baltimore in November 2023.
